285 Birmingham Unison members who do invaluable work looking after people in their own homes, after they have been in hospital, have been forced to take strike action in defence of the service. Following job cuts in the service, the bosses are now trying to savagely cut workers' hours. For many workers it means going from a full time wage to a part time wage—its a massive attack on their livelihoods and this important service. The care workers are striking on 31 Aug, 1, 9, 10, 11, 19, 20, 21, 22, 28, 29, 30, 31, and 1 September. We fully support their strikes.
