Workers at the Cammell Laird shipyard at Birkenhead on Merseyside are striking back following the announcement of 290 job losses (40 percent of the workforce). Famously the workers built the polar research vessel the RRS David Attenborough, otherwise known as “Boaty McBoatface”. The cuts that have been announced are despite £619 million pounds worth of Royal Navy contracts currently on the company’s order books. Join the picket line at the yard every week day until 14 December. We fully support the strikes by Unite and GMB members.
