

# Support Camden traffic warden's strike: 4–17 Feb

Unison members who work in parking enforcement in Camden, central London, are stepping up their fight for decent pay with a further 14 day strike from Monday 4 to Sunday 17 February. This strike will take their total days of strikes to 33.

The Traffic Wardens, who are members of Unison, make millions in profit for the company and millions in revenue for Camden Council. NSL pays its company directors over £250 an hour, but is refusing to pay the traffic wardens just £11.15 an hour. The 400 percent pay rise given to the top director over the last two years would, on its own, cover the cost of raising the wardens' salaries twice over!
